At the time of receipt of your letter, the Regulatory Scrutiny Board, based on its independent assessment, had already selected the main evaluations for scrutiny in 2025. In this context, I take the opportunity to inform you that the 'Evaluation of the legislative framework for tobacco control' has been selected for scrutiny in 2025.
